

End User License Agreement

You have purchased an **Auction!** software license or are running the free demonstration edition. You have the following rights and responsibilities under the license agreement:

This program may be used only by the organization (or single individual) to which the program is licensed. Single user edition may be loaded on one computer for pre- or post- event data entry, and (if needed) on one computer to be used at the event for data entry during the event. Multi-user and Network editions may be loaded on more than one computer as long as the software is used solely by and solely for the benefit of the licensed organization.

“Organization” is defined as a specific site, and does NOT include sites in other communities. For example, schools or churches in a specific diocese must have their own licenses, and remote members of a regional or national organization running physically separate events must have their own licenses. Departments or groups at colleges and universities holding separate events must have their own licenses.

Single user and demo editions do not include the capability to merge two or more independent datasets. Multi-user and network editions include merge capability. Network edition also includes the capability to access a dataset by two or more computers simultaneously.

The program license keys may not be shared by any means, physical or electronic, with any other organizations, or with individuals representing other organizations.

Technical support is available only to the licensee. All requests for technical support must include the name of the licensed organization and the account number for the licensee.

The account number and software license key are specific to the licensed organization. They may not be shared with unauthorized users.

The software may be transferred to a new team member at the licensed organization for subsequent events. The original installation must be removed at time of transfer, and Auction Systems must be notified of the transfer.

The software license may be transferred to another organization when the original licensee no longer uses the software. Auction Systems must be notified in writing. A license transfer form must be completed by both organizations, and notarized. The new licensee must renew technical support at time of transfer.

You may make one backup copy of **Auction!** for your own protection. Copies may not be distributed to any other individuals or organizations.

Auction! is protected by copyright laws that pertain to computer software; it is illegal to make copies except for one backup. It is illegal to give copies to another person, or to duplicate **Auction!** by any other means, including electronic transmission. **Auction!** contains trade secrets, and in order to protect them you may not de-compile, reverse engineer, disassemble, or otherwise reduce **Auction!** to any form that would allow the above. You may not modify, adapt, translate, rent, lease, or create derivative works based on **Auction!** or any part thereof.

Auction Systems warrants that the original CD-ROM is free from defects in material and workmanship, assuming normal use, for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of purchase. If a defect occurs during this period, you may return your faulty media to Auction Systems, and it will be replaced free of charge.

Except for the express warranty of the original media set forth above, Auction Systems grants no other warranties, expressed or implied, by statute or otherwise, regarding the media and their related materials, their fitness for any purpose, their quality, their merchantability, or otherwise. The liability of Auction Systems under the warranty set forth above shall be limited to the amount paid by the customer for the product. In no event shall Auction Systems be liable for any special, consequential or other damages for breach of warrant.
